SAFETY ALERT!



Help us keep our drivers safe and avoid missed pickups. Recycling is manually loaded so please use your Sanico recycling can. If you must use your own can limit the size to 30 gal and weight to 30 lbs. Ensure it is identifiable as recycling.

A NOTE ABOUT CARDBOARD

Cardboard boxes must either fit inside your recycling can, or they must be flattened and bundled (3ft x 3ft) and placed to the side of your recycling can. This keeps them from blowing away and also allows us to fit everyone's cardboard onto the truck.

A NOTE ABOUT SINGLE STREAM

Single Stream recycling means you can mix your recyclables together in one can. The material is brought to a facility where people and machines sort everything back into separate categories where it can be re-used to make new items. This method of recycling is great because it offers households and businesses a much more convenient way to recycle. However, in recent years the rising levels of "contamination" (people throwing improper items into the recycling can) has contributed to a global collapse of the recycling market. This has driven market prices up 10 fold and has made it much harder to find a use for material that contains contamination. WE NEED YOUR HELP! It is extremely important to abide by the recycling rules listed above to avoid any further escalation in recycling disposal fees and surcharges. We may be unable to pick up your recycling if high levels of contamination are present in your can!
